




## MARK YOUR CALENDAR

There's never a shortage of activities in Grandview Heights, from city-sponsored events to outstanding library programming to a host of nearby festivals.



June marks the beginning of the popular **Grandview Hop** season. As other neighborhoods settle down for the evening, the half-mile stretch of Grandview Avenue buzzes to life with music, shopping, art and more. Bring the little ones—the Kids Enterprise Area will keep them entertained while you stroll this sidewalk market, sample food truck creations and sip local craft beer in the pop-up beer garden. The party continues all summer long June to September.

As the weather cools, **Fall Fest** gets heated up in late September. The family-friendly festival at Ray E. DeGraw Park, formerly known as First Avenue Park, is full of fall-themed free activities to complete, inflatables to bounce in, live music to dance to and food trucks to fill your bellies.

Winter brings the annual **Holiday in the Heights**, a holiday tree lighting celebration where a student choir and refreshments are sure to warm your spirits. Take a spin on the iceless skating rink or enjoy the sights of the ice sculpture carving before a visit from Santa Claus himself at Grandview Center.

If live music is your jam, you won't want to miss the concert series presented by the Grandview Heights Public Library. In the summer months, **Music on the Lawn** has been entertaining residents and visitors outside the library for over 35 years with its free tunes and food trucks.

If all of that weren't enough, Grandview Heights' proximity to **The Ohio State University** campus, downtown **Columbus** and the **Arena District** offer plenty of additional options. Watch international athletes compete at the Arnold Sports Festival, catch an Ohio State Buckeyes football game at The 'Shoe, or head to the Arena District for a concert, baseball or hockey game.

- Up your cocktail game at **Endeavor Brewing & Spirits** (909 W 5th Ave), where groups can learn tips and tricks for crafting the perfect cocktail.
- Find your way out of **Escape It Grandview** (1666 W 1st Ave), where themed rooms like a 1920s speakeasy and a fiendish explorer's study await.
- Compete with friends in a round of blacklight mini-golf or experience a realistic game of virtual golf at **Miner 49'er & Caddy's Delight Virtual Golf** (1158B W 3rd Ave).

# THE TABLE IS SET

**What are you hungry for?** Chances are, you'll find it in Grandview Heights, with restaurant menus spanning the globe from **pan-Asian to Mexican to German**. There are a variety of settings, too, to suit everything from a **casual Sunday brunch to drinks at a sidewalk café to a romantic evening out**. Here are just a few of the local favorites you can find in and around the city, organized by area.

As the city's main retail corridor, Grandview Avenue and its adjacent streets have a wealth of options to choose from:

- **Mazah Mediterranean Eatery** (1453 Grandview Ave) serves daily scratch-made Mediterranean dishes and specialty cocktails.
- **Agave & Rye** (1295 Grandview Ave.) Known for their creative, unconventional tacos and delicious hand-crafted cocktails.
- **Figlio Wood Fired Pizza** (1369 Grandview Ave) has an elegant atmosphere to go with its gourmet, wood-fired pies. Next door is sister restaurant VINO VINO, which serves small plates, flatbreads, pasta entrées and, of course, excellent wine.
- **At Third & Hollywood** (1433 W Third Ave), enjoy American fare in a trendy haunt serving up classic cocktails & a popular weekend brunch.
- **Cafe's Round II** (1312 Grandview Ave.) Dine on flavorful BBQ while sipping a beverage from their extensive bourbon selection.
- **Grandview Café** (1455 W Third Ave) is a longtime favorite offering a gastropub-focused menu.
- **The Avenue Steak Tavern** (1307 Grandview Ave), Cameron Mitchell's take on a vintage supper club, brings fine dining to the city.
- **Alchemy Kitchen** (1439 Grandview Ave) is a fast-casual café serving breakfast, lunch and dinner, as well as a full weekend brunch.
- **Bonifacio** (1577 King Ave) Contemporary Filipino bar bites, entrees, dessert & cocktails are served in a casual setting.
- **Aladdin's Eatery** (1425 Grandview Ave) Offering healthy and flavorful Lebanese-American foods that align with and diet ranging from gluten-free to vegan and everything in between.

**Grandview Yard is known for its convenient density of options and proximity to several hotels, as well as downtown Columbus and the Arena District. Here are just a few of the options you'll find there:**

- **At Hofbräuhaus Columbus** (800 Goodale Blvd), enjoy the traditions of Germany, from sausage to schnitzel, alongside steins of house-brewed beer and live music in the evenings. The Biergarten is popular in the warmer months.
- **Brekkie Shack** (1060 Yard St), as its name implies, is an adorable breakfast-centric eatery serving scratch-baked goods.
- **Habaneros Tacos Tequila Mezcal** (1105 Yard St.) offers traditional Mexican flavors and authentic street tacos, tequila infused drinks and mezcal.
- **Winans Chocolates + Coffees + Wine** (1125 Yard St, Ste 240) offers premium chocolates, freshly roasted coffees, great wine and a variety of gifts for someone who deserves an extra treat.

**Venture outside Grandview Yard to discover even more that Grandview Heights and the surrounding neighborhoods have to offer:**

- **DK Diner** (1715 W 3rd Ave), where “DK” stands for “doughnut kitchen,” offers a full dinner menu in addition to a selection of sweet treats and breakfast dishes.
- **LaTavola** (1664 W 1st Ave) is an intimate, charming Old World Italian restaurant from chef/owner and beloved local restaurateur Rick Lopez.
- **Paul's Fifth Avenue** (1565 W 5th Ave) is a Grandview Heights area mainstay offering breakfast and lunch since 1966.
- **Cambridge Tea House** (1885 W 5th Ave) serves charming breakfast, lunch and afternoon tea, with extensive scone and tea menus and monthly prix fixe candlelight dinners.
- **Endeavor Brewing & Spirits** (909 W 5th Ave) puts a global twist on traditional beer styles; a rotating lineup of food trucks keeps patrons' bellies full.
- **High Bank Distillery Co.** (1051 Goodale Blvd) features a full-service bar and restaurant with something for everyone, including vegan and vegetarian diners, as well as a game room for added fun.
- **Watershed Kitchen & Bar** (1145 Chesapeake Ave, Ste D) has been consistently recognized as one of the top dining options in Central Ohio since it opened; the chef's tasting menu and a seasonal craft cocktail are definitely the way to go.
- **Knotty Pine Brewing Co.** (1765 W 3rd Ave) is a brewpub that takes comfort food seriously; enjoy selections from the thoughtful menu alongside house-brewed beers.




Ohio Tap Room

# ARTFUL ACTIVITIES

Grandview Heights is home to two art studios, each with a unique focus.

**The Ohio Craft Museum** (1665 W 5th Ave) features a variety of rotating exhibitions featuring works in clay, fiber, glass, metal, wood and more. Don't miss the gift shop on your way out, where you'll find an array of hand-crafted jewelry, home décor, textiles, serving ware and more.

**Open Door Art Studio & Gallery** (1050 Goodale Blvd) has a unique twist: The studio provides creative space and support for adults with developmental disabilities to foster their artistic talent. Gallery exhibitions change every few weeks, so there's always something new to discover.

## HISTORY IN THE MAKING



Grandview Avenue is known for its excellent retail options today, but this status is not new. The "Bank Block" section, along the west side of the avenue from 1255 to 1307, developed by Don M. Casto, Sr. in 1927, was named for its first anchor tenant: First Citizens Trust, later renamed as the Ohio National Bank. The Bank Block was built in 1927 as America's first strip shopping center with integrated parking. Today, that longevity is honored by the block's spot on the National Register of Historic Places and is marked with an Ohio Historical Marker, near Stauf's Coffee Roasters (1277 Grandview Ave).

# BE WELL

A small footprint and widely available bike lanes make Grandview Heights an ideal city for traveling by foot or two wheels.

Don't have a bike of your own? **CoGo Bike Share** has seven docking stations in and around the city, with easy access to the **Olentangy Trail** via a newly built connector path near Grandview Yard. Thanks to a partnership with **Lyft**, finding a docking station and renting and returning a bicycle is easily accomplished through the Lyft app.



## EXPERIENCE THE GREAT OUTDOORS

Grandview Heights' 15 parks comprise a total of 45 acres. Wyman Woods and McKinley Field also feature rentable shelter houses, perfect for that family reunion picnic.



The city is home to a vast number of salons, spas and workout studios covering a wide range of disciplines, from yoga to CrossFit to barre and beyond. Here are just a few that are within easy access of the hotels at Grandview Yard:



- **Esporta Fitness** (850 Goodale Blvd) has a location in Grandview Yard and features an indoor pool, sauna, racquetball, personal training and group classes.
- **Club Pilates** (1080 Yard St) offers four experience levels, meaning there's a class for everyone from beginners to masters.
- At **MY SALON Suite** (1090 Yard St), nearly 30 independent stylists offer a range of hair, skin and nail services, including spray tanning and medical aesthetics.
- At **Open Sky Day Spa** (1124 Goodale Blvd), you can schedule a massage in a variety of styles, from ashatsu and floor Thai to Swedish and deep tissue. There's also a range of facial and nail services available.
